Beneficiaries 2022

People in economic need received 65.4% of instances & 47.3% of the amount, reflecting socioeconomic challenges.

Health issues support accounted for 9% of instances & 13.7% of the amount, addressing immediate medical needs.





People with disabilities saw strategic giving, with 31% of instances intended for long-term solutions.

Local communities received 10% of instances & 4.4% of the amount, benefiting from community-based improvements.





General population received 2.5% of instances & 24.8% of amount, largely due to support for the Kosovo Security Fund.
