## WHAT ARE THE EFFECTS OF GIVING?

Kosovo's philanthropic giving in 2022 focused on short-term relief, with long-term giving at a record low. Addressing immediate needs and socioeconomic conditions dictated donation use.

## **Structure of Giving by Intended Effects 2022**





Short-term giving made up 81.3% of instances, focusing on humanitarian support, supplies, housing, and medical treatments.

Long-term giving comprised 15.5% of instances, with equipment donations (educational, medical, adaptive) making up 97.5% of the donated amount.
