

Giving Kosovo 2022 Report on the state of philanthropy

HOW DOES KOSOVO SUPPORT MARGINALIZED GROUPS?

From 2018 to 2022, citizens and companies in Kosovo donated more than 2,5 million EUR through 438 philanthropy actions to support healthcare. The level of support was the highest in 2019 when more than 819 thousand EUR were donated, and in the pandemic year, more than 1.1 million EUR were donated.

Trends in Giving for Marginalized Groups in Kosovo 2018 - 2022



Who Gave The Most for Marginalized Groups in Kosovo in 2022?

In 2022, more than 185 thousand EUR were donated to support marginalized groups. The corporate sector participated in the largest number of instances of giving, while individuals donated the largest amount.



Who Are The Recipients of Support for Marginalized Groups?

In 2022 donors contributed mainly through civil society organizations (nonprofits) – both in terms of donated amount and instances of giving.



CSOs (Nonprofits) 76.5%

Donations for marginalized groups mostly have short-term effects regarding the number of instances of giving. But if we look at donated sum, long-term effects donations are dominant.





CSOs (nonprofits) have been the number one recipient in the last five years.
