



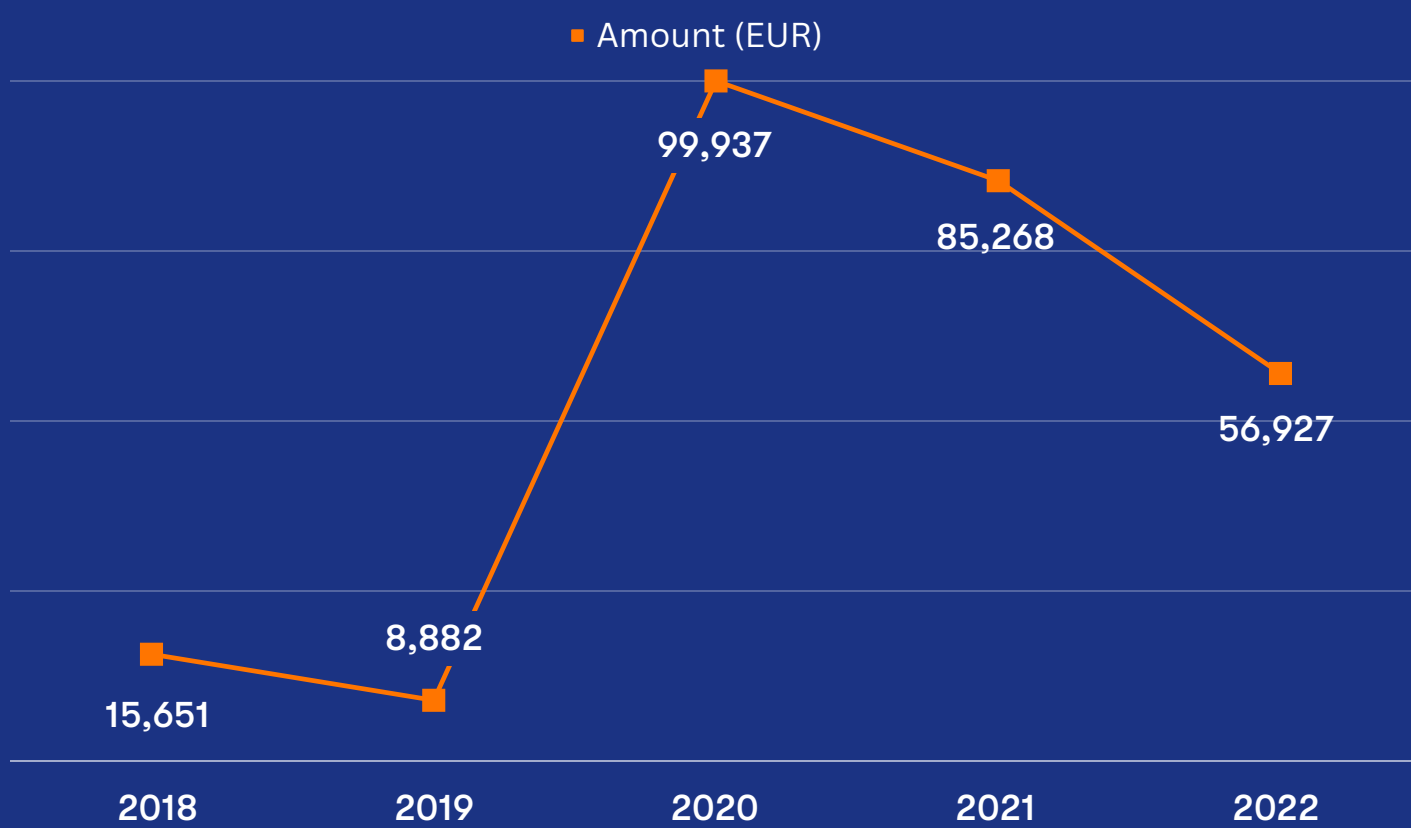
Giving Kosovo 2022

REPORT ON THE STATE OF PHILANTHROPY

SEASONAL GIVING IN KOSOVO 2018-2022

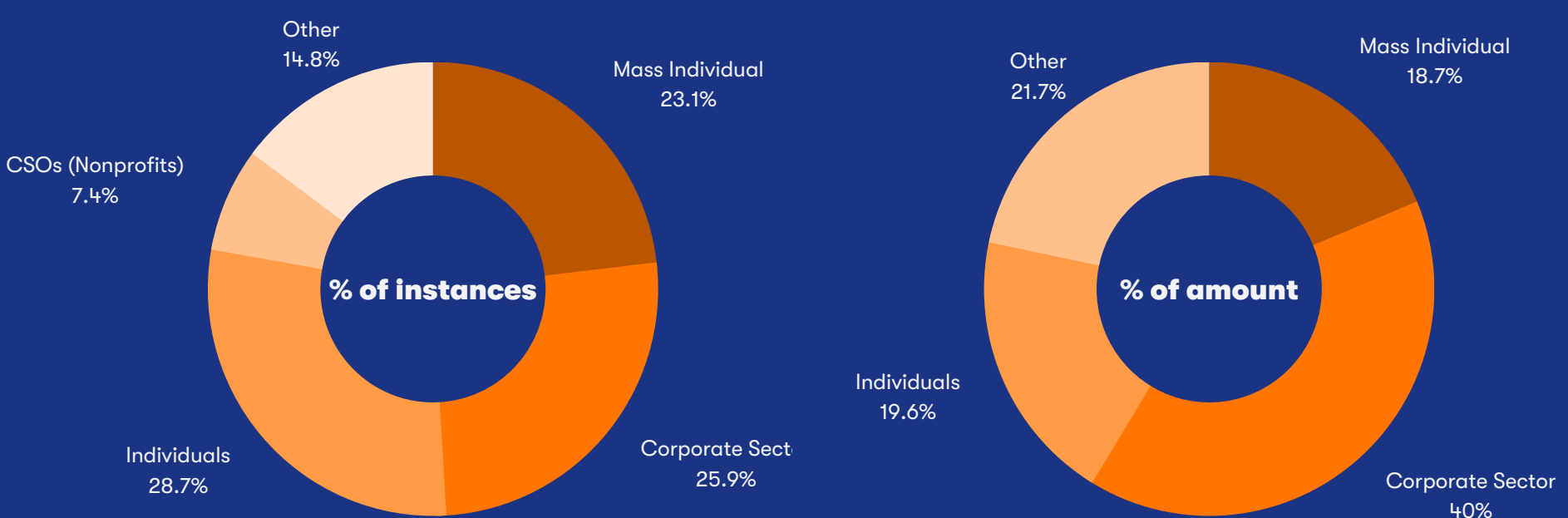
From 2018 to 2022, citizens and companies in Kosovo donated more than 266 thousand EUR through 300 philanthropy actions for purposes of seasonal giving. The level of support was the highest in the pandemic year when more than 99 thousand EUR were donated.

Trends in Seasonal Giving



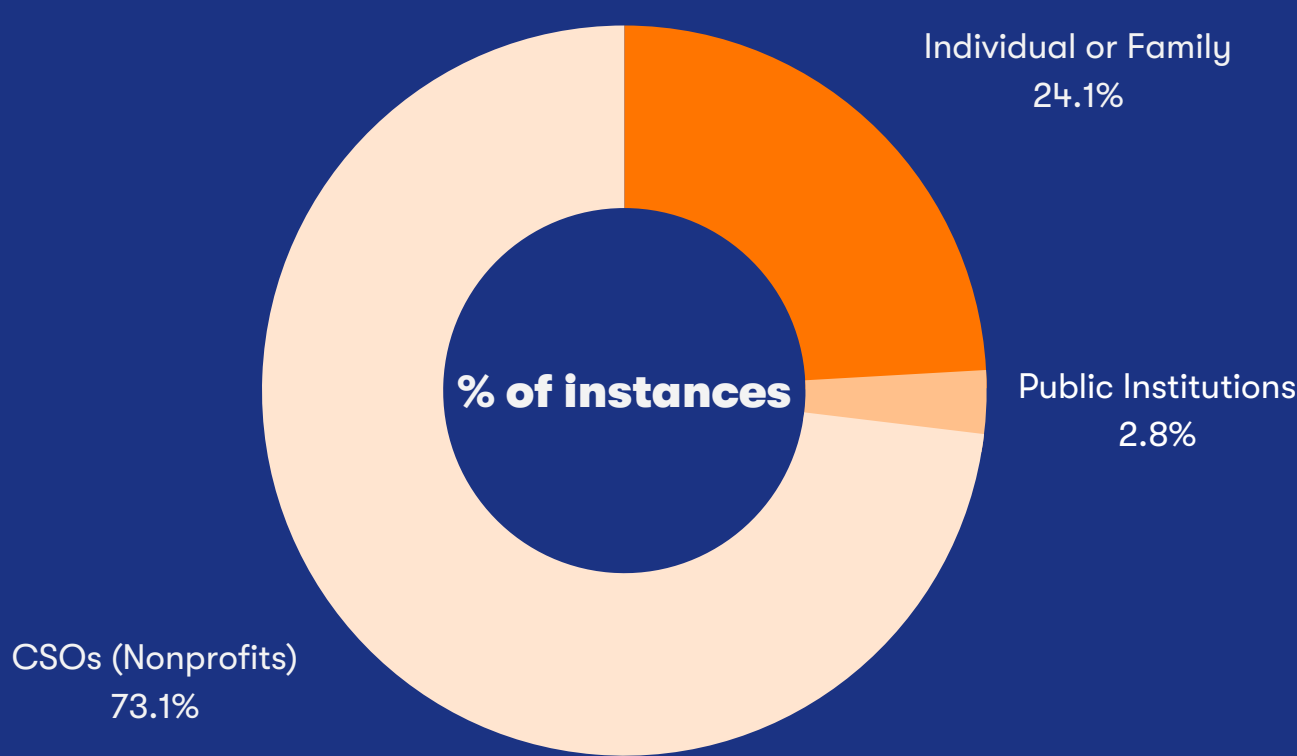
Who Contributed The Most to Seasonal Giving in Kosovo in 2022?

In 2022, more than 56 thousand EUR were donated for seasonal giving. The corporate sector donated the largest amount while individuals participated in the largest number of instances of giving.



Who Received Support Through Seasonal Giving in Kosovo in 2022?

In 2022 donors contributed mainly through civil society organizations (**nonprofits**) – both in terms of donated amount and instances of giving.



In 2022, CSOs (**nonprofits**) received 98.4% of the total amount donated for the purposes of seasonal giving.



People in economic need have been the beneficiaries of all the funds raised through seasonal giving in Kosovo in 2022.
