

Giving Kosovo 2022 Report on the state of philanthropy

THE ROLE OF DIASPORA IN KOSOVO'S PHILANTHROPY ECOSYSTEM

The diaspora, one of the most significant assets in developing Kosovo's economy, has had a substantial and active role in the philanthropic ecosystem in Kosovo throughout the years. According to data from Catalyst Balkans' database, from 2018 until 2022, diaspora donors helped Kosovo's citizens with donations valued at more than 5.8 million euros.

What Causes Did the Diaspora Support the Most in 2022?

In 2022 the most supported causes were Poverty Relief/Migration and Education, both in terms of instances and the donated sum.



To Whom the Diaspora Gave in 2022?

The primary focus of giving from the diaspora was to give directly to individuals and families (53.6% of instances) in 2022, with giving to nonprofits (civil society organizations) at 41.1% being another strong giving pathway.



People in economic need have been the most supported beneficiary type in the last five years.





In 2022, as much as 25% of the sum donated by the Kosovo diaspora was donated with strategic goals, which is slight raise from 2021, when long-term donations comprised 21.4% of the donated amount.
