

Giving Kosovo 2022 Report on the state of philanthropy

HOW DOES KOSOVO SUPPORT CULTURE AND ART?

From 2018 to 2022, citizens and companies in Kosovo donated more than 209,293 EUR to support culture & art. In the past three years, the most prominent donors were citizens (through mass individual giving) and individuals who covered all philanthropy actions intended for culture & art, while in 2018 and 2019, nonprofits (CSOs) and the corporate sector also gave important contributions.

Who Were the Recipients in 2022?

In 2022, only two recipient groups got support for culture and art – CSOs (nonprofits) and public institutions.



What Were the Intended Effects of Giving for Culture & Art in 2022?

Around half of the instances of giving for culture and art were one-off donations, 25% are unknown, and 25% are donations with long-term effects.



Local communities were the beneficiary groups that received 100% of the amount donated in 2022, and 100% benefited from 100% of instances of giving.





In 2022, 25% of donations for culture and art were from the diaspora, while the rest was support from domestic donors.
