



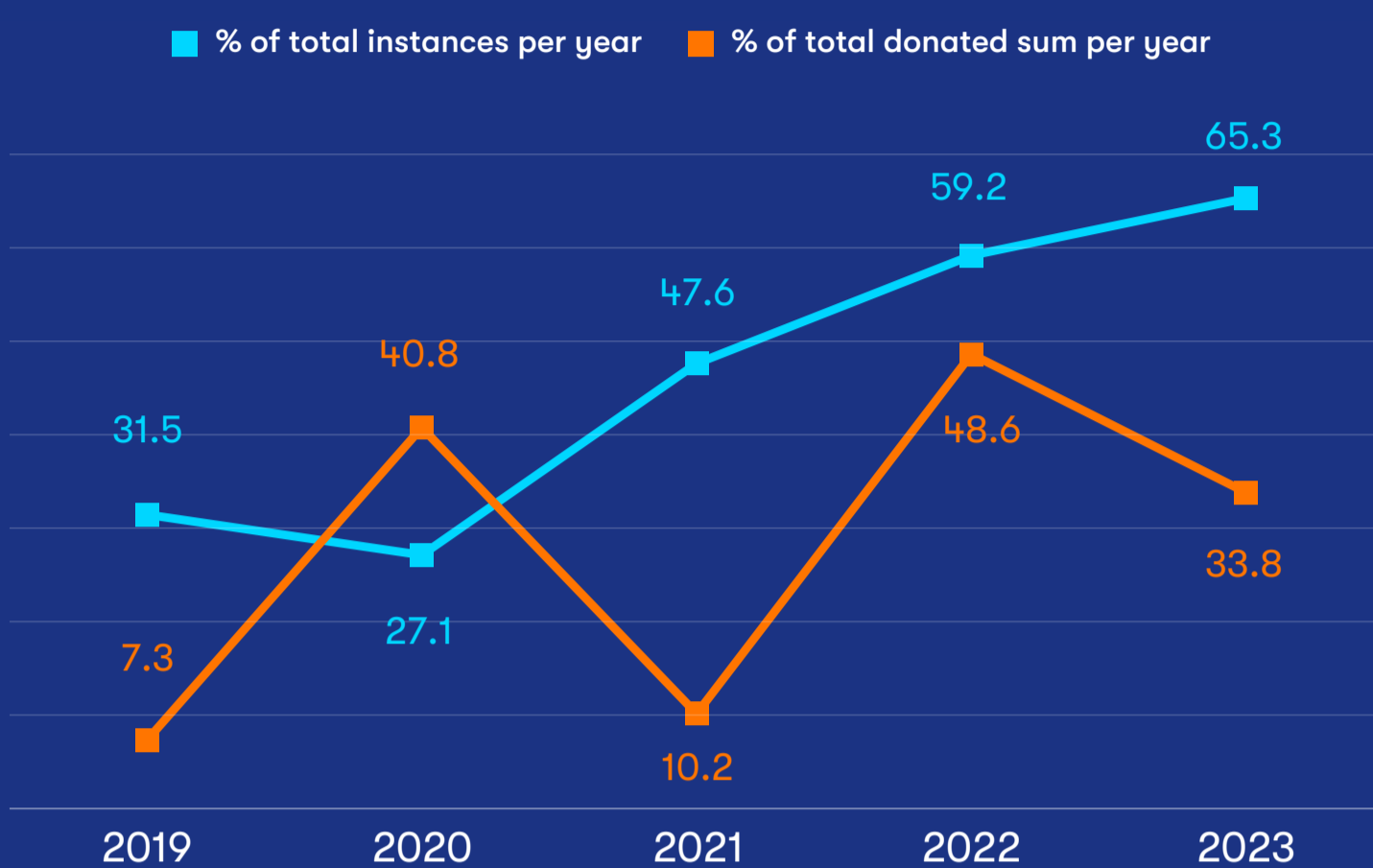

# POVERTY RELIEF EFFORTS IN KOSOVO IN 2023

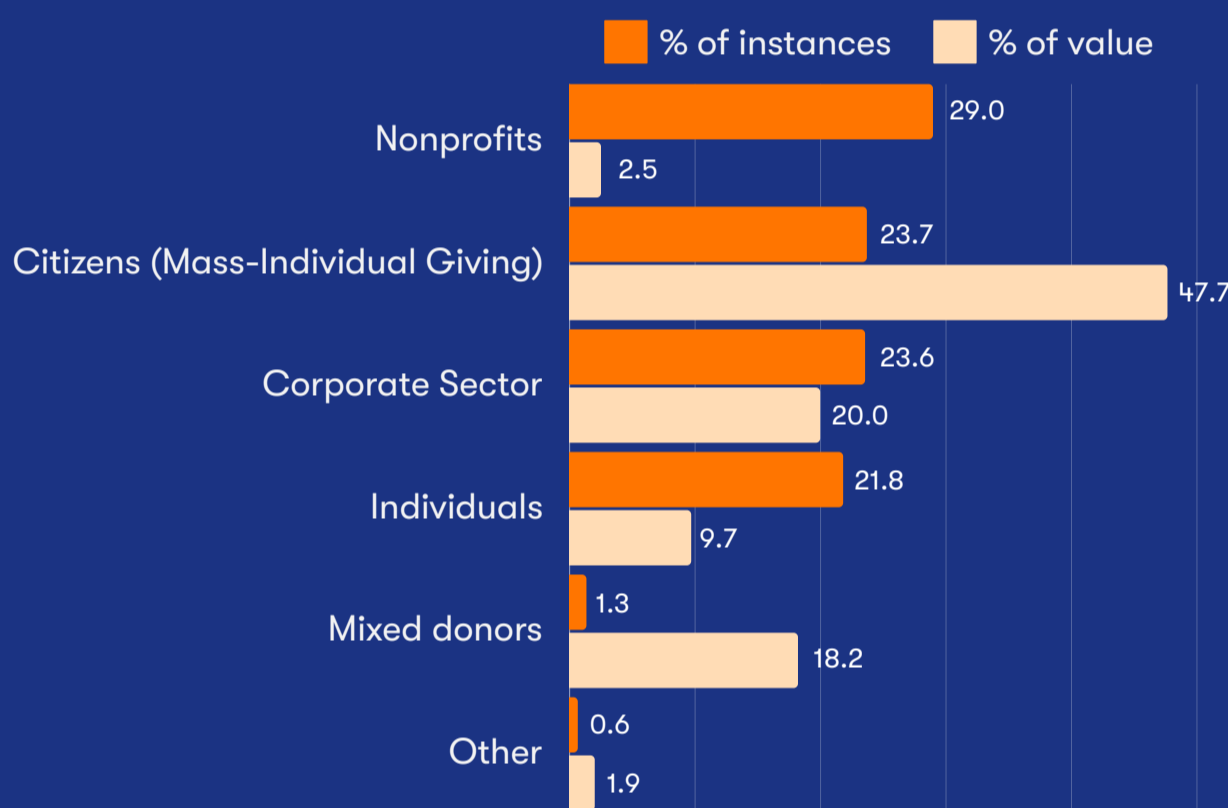
Poverty relief has been the most supported philanthropic cause in Kosovo in 2023, following a rising trend from the previous years.

### Trends in support for poverty relief in Kosovo 2019-2023

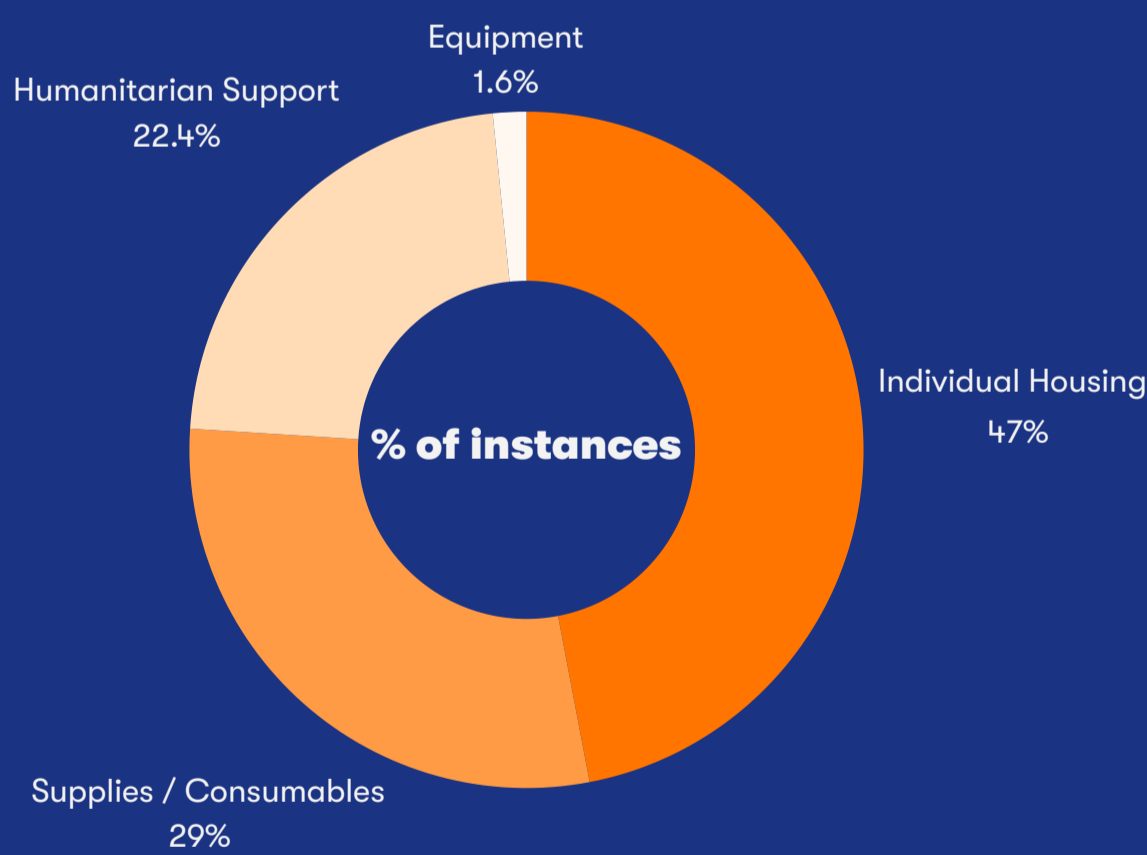


### Donors Supporting Poverty Relief in Kosovo in 2023

CSOs and citizens have been the most frequent donor type supporting the cause of poverty. Giving for this cause recorded a total of 2,904 instances.



### Poverty Relief – Usage of Donations in 2023



160,000 EUR was raised by the Kosovar diaspora in London, through a charity event organized by Xhavit Krasniqi, to support the Balkans Orphans Association in their mission to provide aid to families in economic need in Skenderaj and Suhareka.



Hil Group Sh.P.K. donated clothing estimated at over 40,000 EUR to the “Bereqeti” Association. This clothing was then distributed to individuals in economic need throughout Kosovo.
