



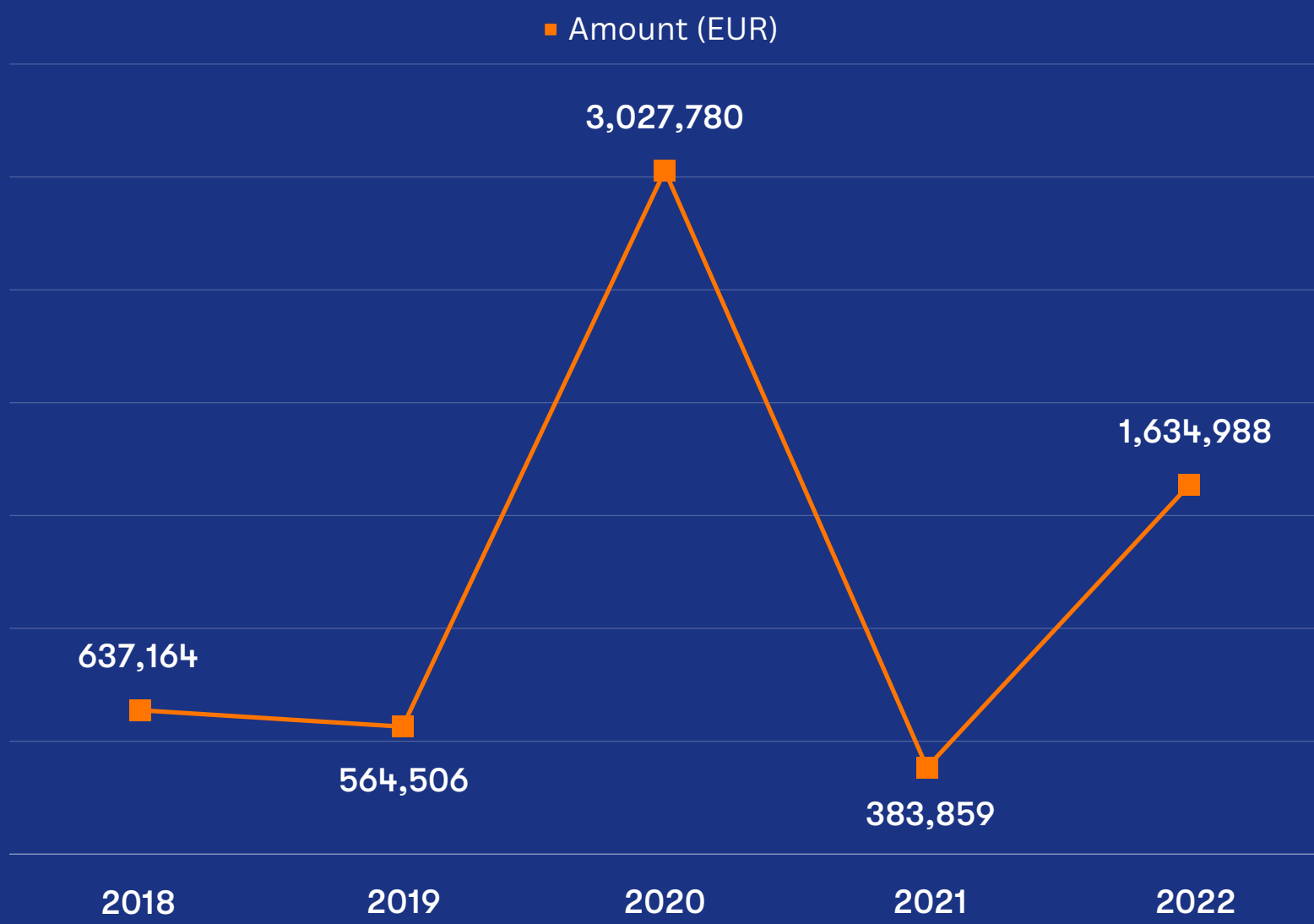
Giving Kosovo 2022

REPORT ON THE STATE OF PHILANTHROPY

HOW DOES KOSOVO SUPPORT PEOPLE IN ECONOMIC NEED?

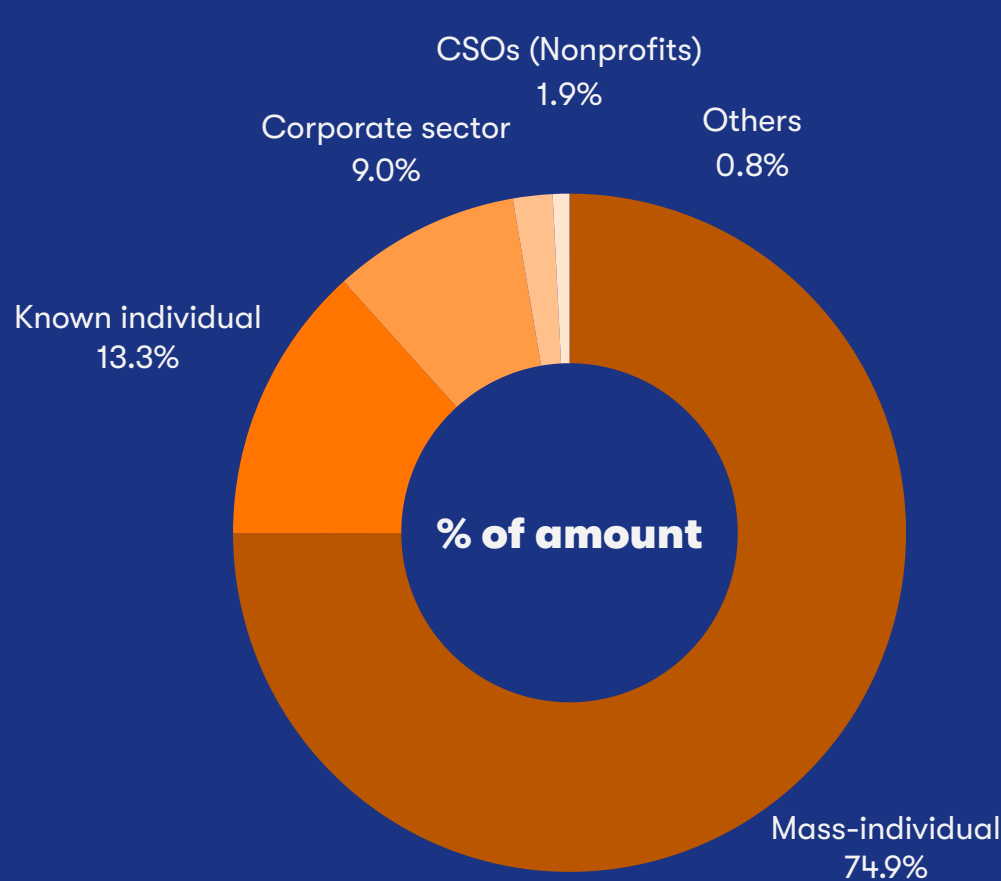
From 2018 to 2022, citizens and companies in Kosovo donated more than 6.2 million EUR through 1,660 instances of giving to support people in economic need. The most significant amount was donated in 2020 when donors supported this beneficiary group with more than 3 million EUR. In 2022, people in economic need were supported with more than 1.6 million EUR through 602 instances of giving.

Trends in Giving for People in Economic Need



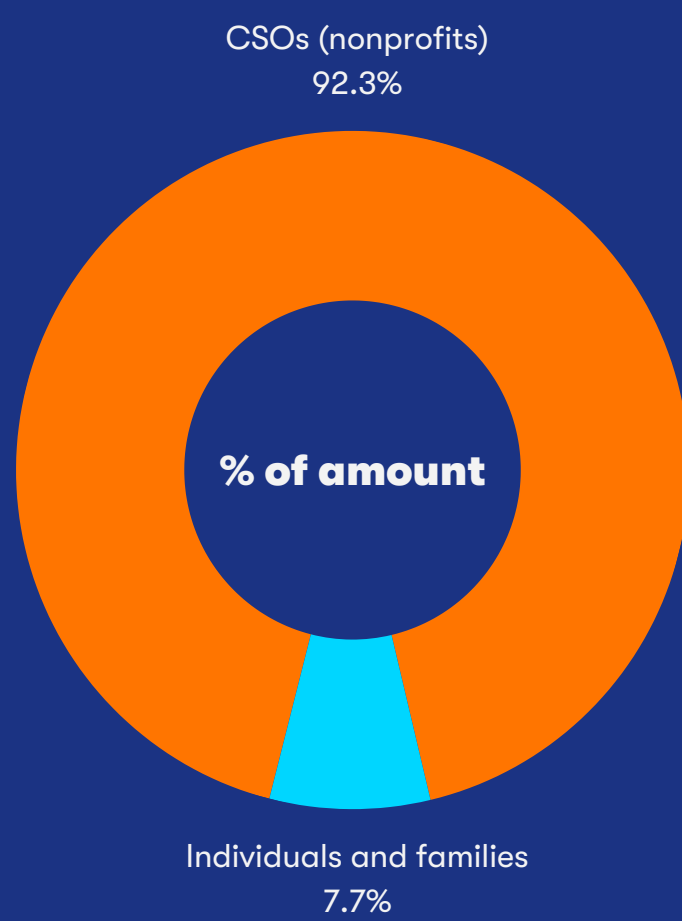
Who were the Donors in 2022?

Last year, citizens, through mass giving, contributed the most and donated 74.9% of the total amount, participating in 34.7% of giving instances.



Who were Recipients in 2022?

Two recipient groups that channeled the support to people in economic need were CSOs ([nonprofits](#)) and individuals and families.



Donations for people in economic need were mostly one-off donations, providing short-term relief in 99.6% of the donated sums and 96% of donation instances



The diaspora supported people in economic need with more than 280 thousand EUR in 2022 through 91 instances of giving.
