

Giving Kosovo 2022 Report on the state of philanthropy

HOW DOES KOSOVO SUPPORT POVERTY RELIEF?

From 2018 to 2022, citizens and companies in Kosovo donated more than 4.8 million EUR to support poverty relief. The most significant amounts were donated in 2020 when donors helped fight poverty with over 1.8 million EUR and in 2022, when the donated sum amounted to 1.6 million.



Trends in Giving for Poverty Relief



Who were the Donors in 2022?

In 2022, citizens, through mass giving, contributed the most and donated 78% of the total amount, participating in 37.5% of giving instances.



Who were Recipients in 2022?

In 2022, only two recipient groups got support – CSOs (nonprofits) and individuals and families.



People in economic need were the beneficiary groups that received 100% of the amount donated in 2022 and benefited from 97.5% of instances of giving.





In 2022, almost the entirety of the donated sum (99.9%) has been provided through short-term effect giving. Donations aimed at long-term effects comprised only 0.1% of the donated sum.
