

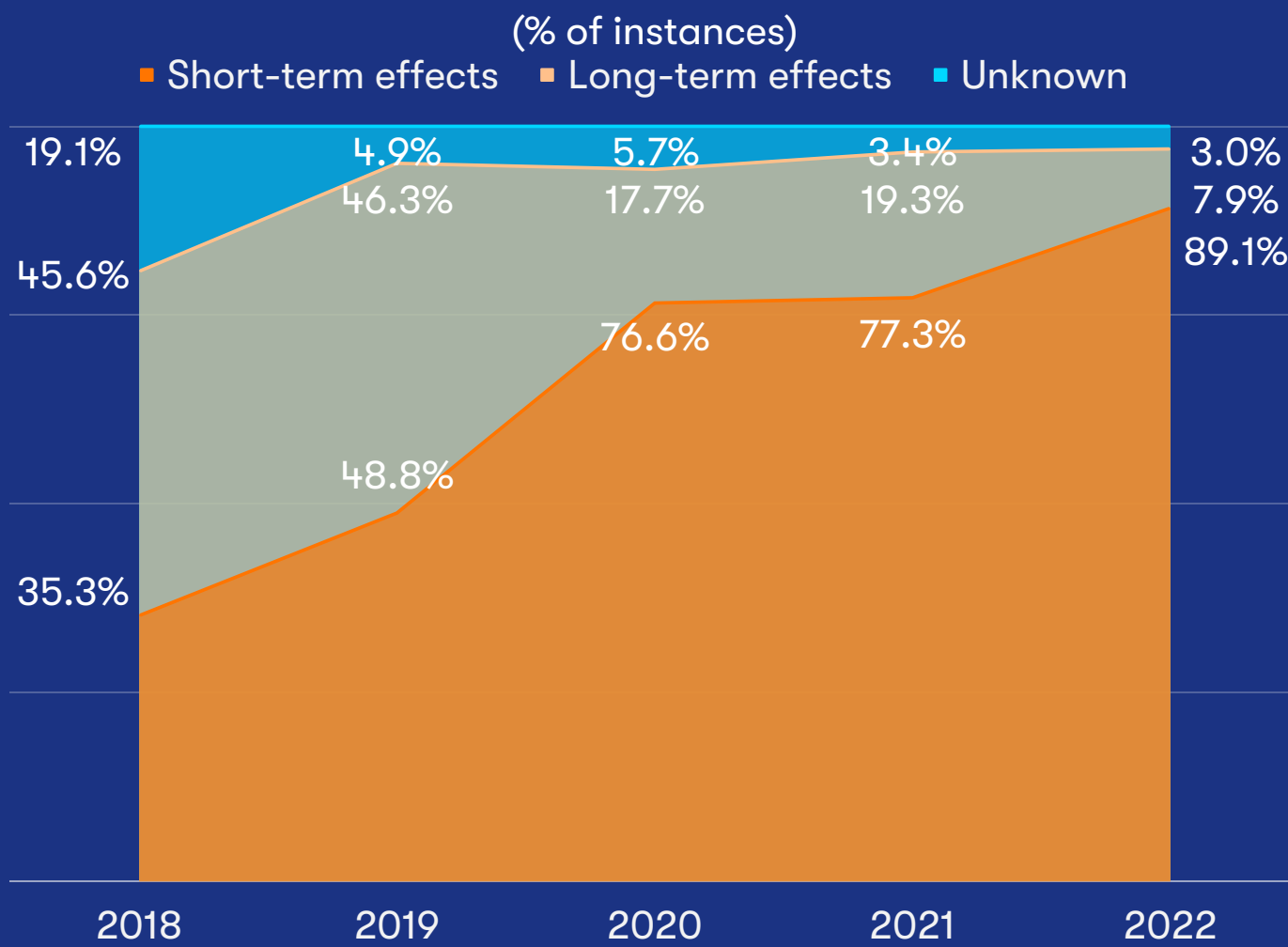


Kosovo Giving to CSOs 2022

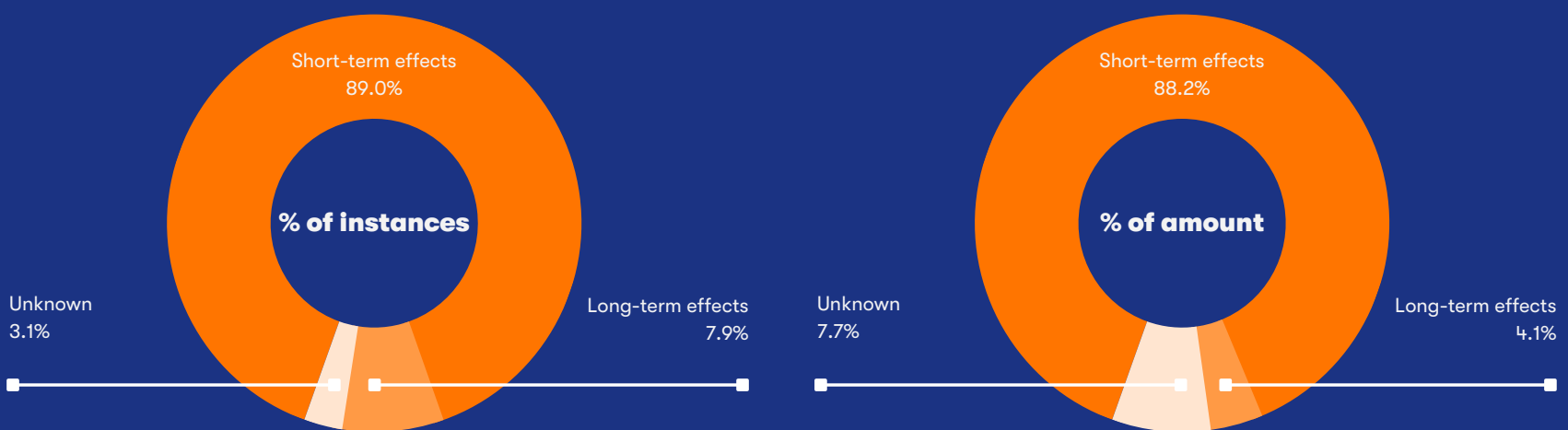
What were the intended effects of donations?

The trend of increase in donations with short-term effects continued in 2022, as the percentage of instances of short-term giving reached around 90%.

Kosovo Giving to CSOs - Inteded Effects 2018-2022



Giving to CSOs: Donor Type Structure in Kosovo in 2022



Donations with short-term intended effects generated around 90% instances in 2022 which is the highest percentage since 2018.



Long-term giving saw a decrease and had a share of 7.9% instances in 2022.

Most frequent form of donations with short-term intended effects were supplies and consumables, while equipment was the most frequent form of donations with long-term effects.
