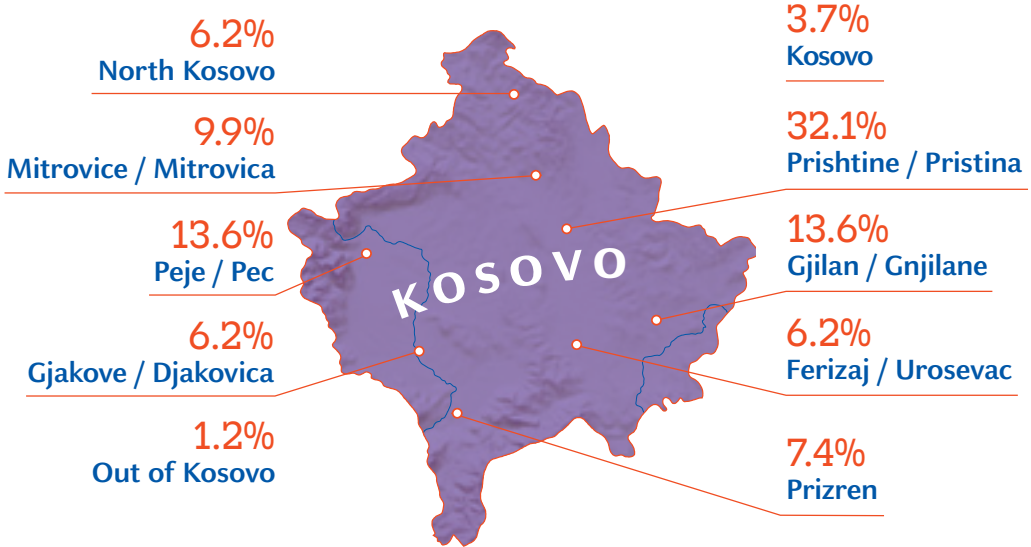

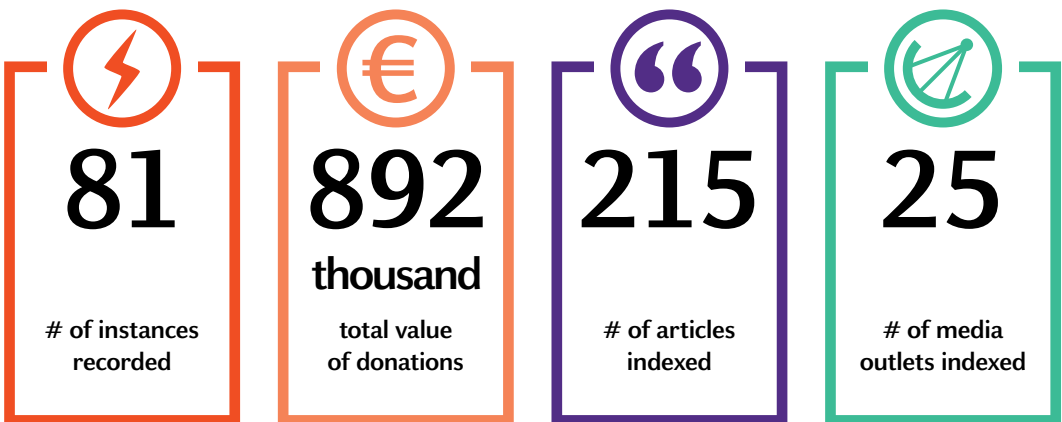

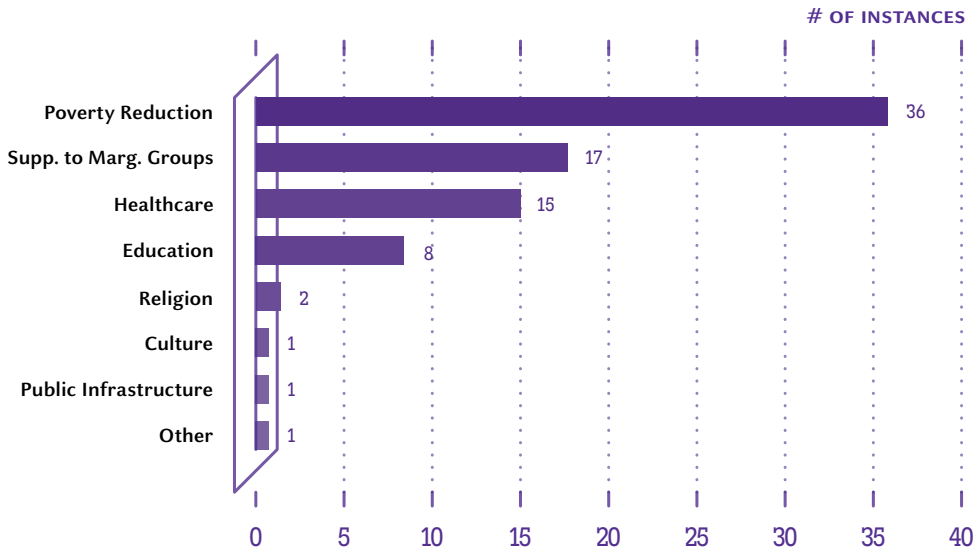


Geographic Distribution

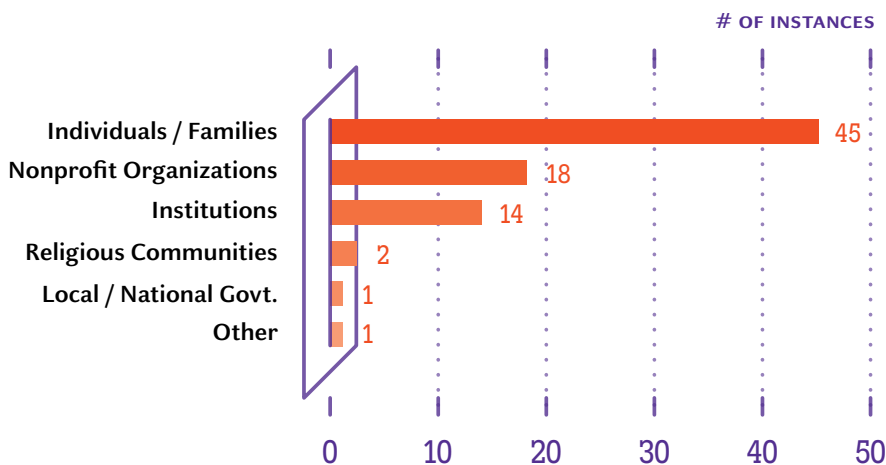

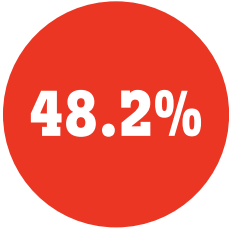

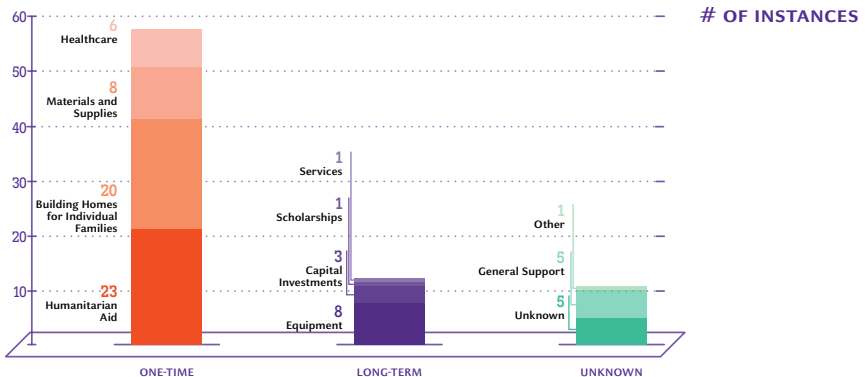

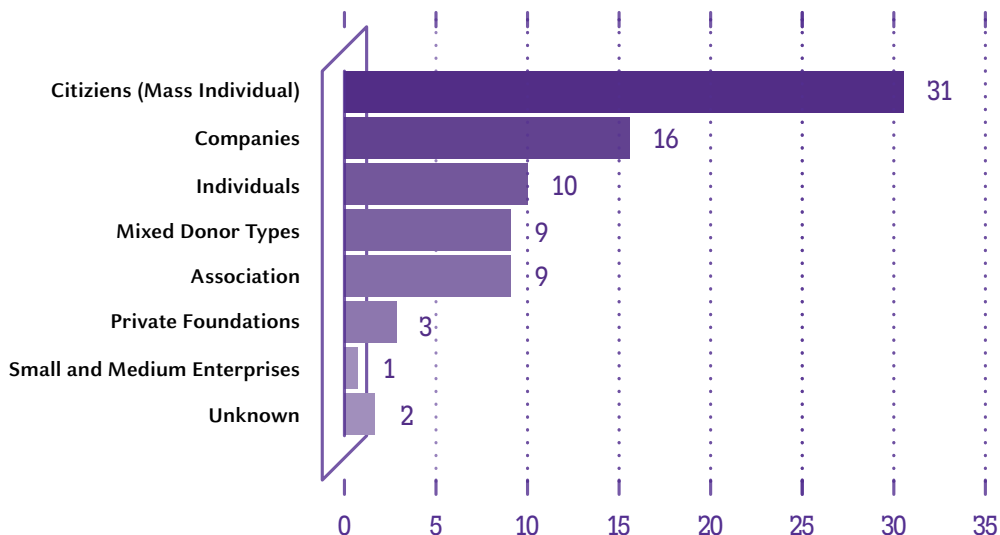

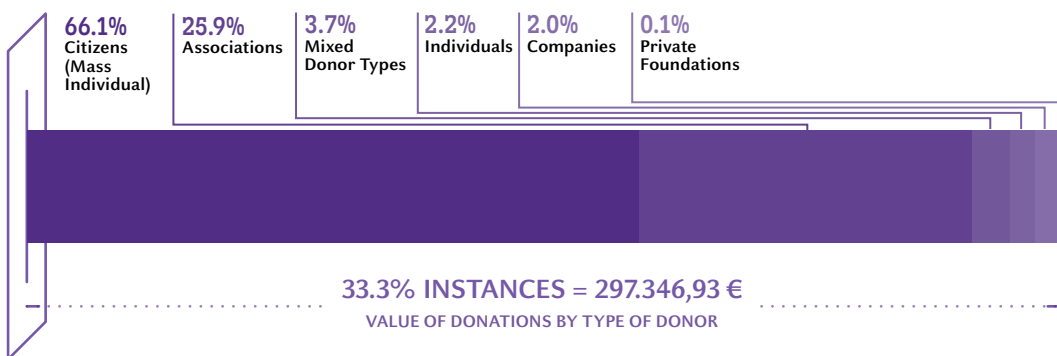
Use of Donations
